## A brief description of each day.

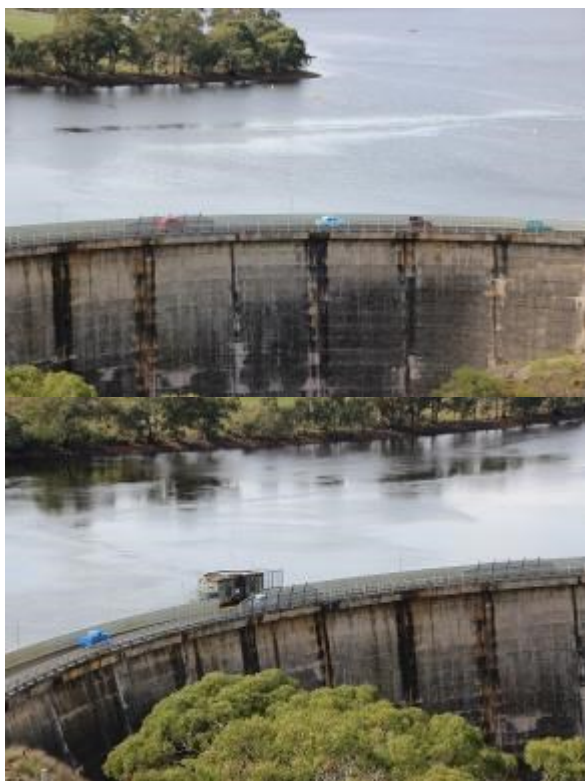
